October Recipe

You might even try adding spinach for a hearty meal. This will bring back memories of when the air was crisp and a warm bowl of soup hit the spot. All you might be missing is a fireplace! if you make it, send us a picture and a review. Happy Cookin

Creamy Parmesan Italian Sausage Ditalini Soup

- 1 lb Italian sausage, casings removed
- 1 tbsp olive oil
- 1 small onion, diced
- 2 cloves garlic, minced
- 1 can (14.502) diced tomatoes, drained
- 4 cups chicken broth
- 1 cup heavy cream
- 1 cup small pasta (ditalini or elbow)
- 1 cup shredded parmesan cheese
- 1/2 tsp dried basil
- 1/2 tsp dried oregano
 - Salt and pepper, to taste
- Fresh parsley, chopped (for garnish)

Directions:

1. Cook the Sausage: Heat olive oil in a large pot over medium heat. Add the Italian sausage breaking it up as it cooks until it is browned. Remove the sausage from the pot and set it aside.



- 2. Sauté the Aromatics: In the same pot, add the diced onion and minced garlic. Cook until the onion is translucent, about 3-4 minutes.
- 3. Add Tomatoes and Broth: Stir in the drained diced tomatoes, chicken broth, dried basil, and the oregano. Bring the mixture to a boil.
- 4. Cook the Pasta: Add the pasta to the boiling broth mixture and cook until it is al dente, approximately 8-10 minutes.
- 5. Make it Creamy: Reduce the heat to medium-low. Stir in the heavy cream and shredded parmesan cheese, allowing the cheese to melt and thicken the
- 6. Add Sausage Back In: Return the cooked sausage to the pot, stirring to combine with the soup. Season with salt and pepper to taste.
- 7. Serve: Ladle the soup into bowls, garish with freshly chopped parsley, and enjoy this hearty Italianinspired meal!



Hurricane Tips for Pets

In the event of a hurricane, it is crucial to have a well-prepared emergency kit for your pet. The number one instruction for pet owners is to *bring your pets* with you when evacuating.



Pets that help people with disabilities are allowed in General Population Shelters and Red Cross Shelters as long as they meet the requirements for service animals under federal law. However, only select emergency shelters accept regular pets (non-service animals), so finding a pet-friendly shelter may be difficult.

Contact your local emergency management agency for information about which emergency shelters allow pets. Try to call the shelter before you go, as some pet-friendly shelters may require advance notice. Your local humane society or veterinary hospital may also have information about where you can take your pets during an evacuation.

Instead of a shelter, you can also go to a petfriendly hotel or motel. Have a list of pet-friendly lodging handy in case you need to evacuate quickly. Here are the essential items to include in your pet's emergency kit:

- Food and Water: Ensure your pet has access to safe food and water, even if the water is not drinkable.
- Medications: Bring your pet's medications, especially if they require them for their health.
- Toiletries: Include items like pee pads, paper towels, and similar items for your pet to use while out and about.
- Microchip: Make sure your pet is microchipped for easy identification if separated.
- Identification: Bring your pet's collar with ID tags displaying contact information.
- Vaccination Records: Have proof of your pet's vaccinations and other important documents. These items will help ensure your pet's safety and comfort during a hurricane. Remember to regularly check and update your supplies, rotating food and medications as needed.

With a little planning and preparation, you can keep your furry companions safe and secure during the most challenging times.


