Recipe Corner

Southwest Chicken and Black Bean Casserole


Ingredients:

- 2 cups shredded cooked chicken
- 1 can (15 oz) black beans, drained and rinsed
- 1 can (15 oz) corn, drained
- 1 can (10 oz) diced tomatoes with green chilies
- 1 cup cooked rice, either white or brown
- 1 cup shredded cheddar cheese
- 1 teaspoon chili powder
- 1 teaspoon cumin
- 1/2 teaspoon garlic powder
- 1/2 teaspoon onion powder
- Salt and pepper, according to taste
- 1/4 cup chopped fresh cilantro, for garnish
- Sour cream, optional for serving

Instructions:

- 1. Preheat your oven to 375°F (190°C).
- 2. In a large mixing bowl, combine the shredded chicken, black beans, corn, diced tomatoes with green chilies, cooked rice, chili powder, cumin, garlic powder, onion powder, salt, and pepper. Mix thoroughly to ensure even distribution of all ingredients.
- 3. Transfer the mixture into a greased 9x13 inch baking dish, spreading it out evenly.
- 4. Evenly sprinkle shredded cheddar cheese over the top of the mixture in the baking dish.
- 5. Cover the baking dish with aluminum foil and bake for 25 minutes. Then, remove the foil and continue baking for an additional 10-15 minutes, or until the cheese is melted and bubbly.
- 6. Once baked, remove the casserole from the oven and allow it to cool for a few minutes. Garnish with chopped fresh cilantro before serving. If desired, add a dollop of sour cream on top when serving.




